The Pacific Symposium for Science & Sustainability (PS³) is a unique experience bringing approximately 50 highly motivated high school students from Hawai'i and other Pacific Islands together for a weekend of science discussion. PS³ is much like professional conferences—students present research papers to scientists & their peers.



Selected participants and their teachers receive an expense paid weekend at a hotel in Honolulu, Hawai'i. Activities include a dinner mixer, awards ceremony, and a field trip.



Papers are judged by professionals from science and engineering fields. Cash prizes for college scholarships are awarded to the top finalists* along with an all-expense paid trips to the National Junior Science and Humanities Symposium where they'll represent Hawai'i and the Pacific Rim.
